

• Lemax Street Lamp 'post holder bases stands' - 5 Pack – I'd never seen these before. They appeared for sale on eBay (only in Europe); it means I don't know the cost. We use pins, tacky wax, etc., to secure lamps, but another 'fix' is always good. These snap on Lemax streetlamps and could be glued down (and painted to match the surface color) – good ideas.

• 1/64th Scale, Lockheed P-38J Lightning "Marge." Named in recognition of his girl-friend/wife; her name and image were on the fuselage of the aircraft. He, Richard Bong, was the U.S.A., Ace of Aces. Shot down 40 enemy aircraft during WW II. Born in Poplar, WI., (less than an hour from here). https://www.treefrogtreasures.com/ 9 in. wingspan, 6 in. nose to tail. Note: My family members knew him growing up; I met Marge while they were finishing the Bong Memorial in Superior, WI. I mentioned the memorial in JSYK May 5, 2021 and May 21, 2021.
