

Short Teaser Promo Trailers for Your Video



It was never posted on YouTube. After seeing her video, I just had to try this!

My wife Laura and I always make sure we go early enough to the movies to catch all the trailers for upcoming films. How else do you know if you might want to see that movie? As soon as it's posted on YouTube it goes out as an email link to your subscribers. They're already primed for a new video (Oh boy! New content!) from you. You can reach others via posting on Facebook group pages that focus on Christmas villages. I received 26 likes and 32 comments. It was viewed 938 times.

2020 was the *annus horribilis* that we lived during the depths of the Covid-19 pandemic. Planning and working on your village that year was therapy for the time we hunkered down. I found an amazing song called *Christmas Virus*, and then I was off and running:

If you can post the trailer soon enough, folks get excited, and I was able to post the promo in early October. They're planning and building their own village displays, too. The 2020 promo trailer has 639 views and 29 comments.


